

STEPHEN SONDHEIM

STEPHEN SONDHEIM (Composer) wrote the music and lyrics for SUNDAY IN THE PARK WITH GEORGE (1984), MERRILY WE ROLL ALONG (1981), SWEENEY TODD (1979), PACIFIC OVERTURES (1976), A LITTLE NIGHT MUSIC (1973), THE FROGS (1974), FOLLIES (1971), COMPANY (1970), ANYONE CAN WHISTLE (1964) and A FUNNY THING HAPPENED ON THE WAY TO THE FORUM (1962), as well as the lyrics for DO I HEAR A WALTZ? (1965), GYPSY (1959) and WEST SIDE STORY (1957), and additional lyrics for CANDIDE (1973). SIDE BY SIDE BY SONDHEIM (1976), MARRY ME A LITTLE (1981) and YOU'RE GONNA LOVE TOMORROW (originally presented as A STEPHEN SONDHEIM EVE-NING on March 3, 1983) are anthologies of his work as composer and lyricist. He composed the film scores for STAVISKY (1974) and REDS (1981), songs for a television production, EVENING PRIM-ROSE (1966), and co-authored the film THE LAST OF SHEILA He provided incidental music for Broadway's TWIGS (1971), GIRLS OF SUMMER (1956) and INVITATION TO A MARCH (1961). He won Tony Awards as Best Composer and Lyricist for SWEENEY TODD, A LITTLE NIGHT MUSIC, FOLLIES and COM-PANY. All of these musicals won the New York Drama Critics' Circle Award, as did PACIFIC OVERTURES and SUNDAY IN THE PARK WITH GEORGE, the latter also receiving the Pulitzer Prize in 1985. Mr. Sondheim was born and raised in New York City and graduated from Williams College, winning the Hutchinson Prize for Music Composition. After graduation he studied theory and composition with Milton Babbitt. He is on the council of the Dramatists Guild, the national association of playwrights, composers and lyricists, having served as its president from 1973 to 1981, and was elected to the American Academy and Institute of Arts and Letters in 1983.
